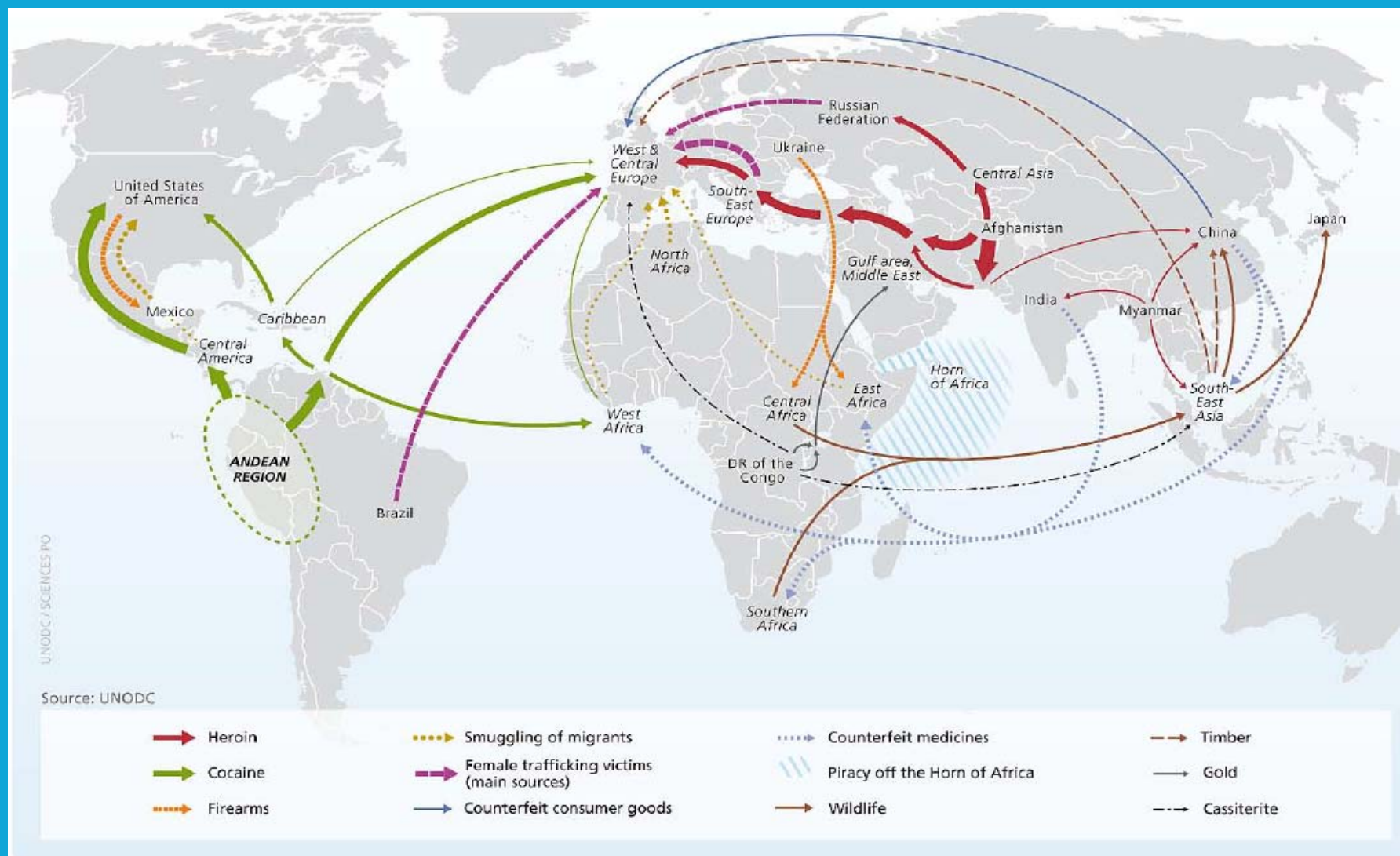

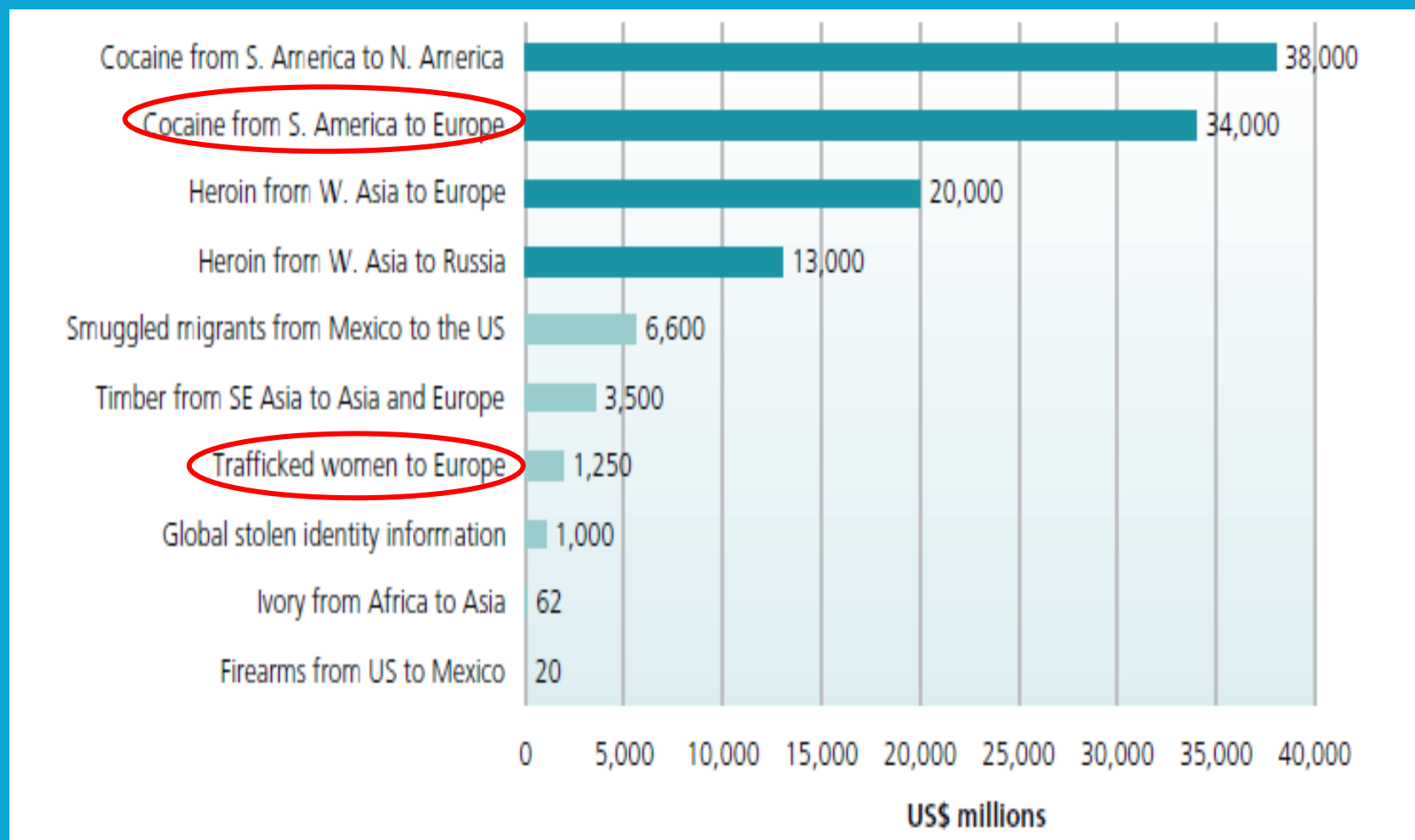

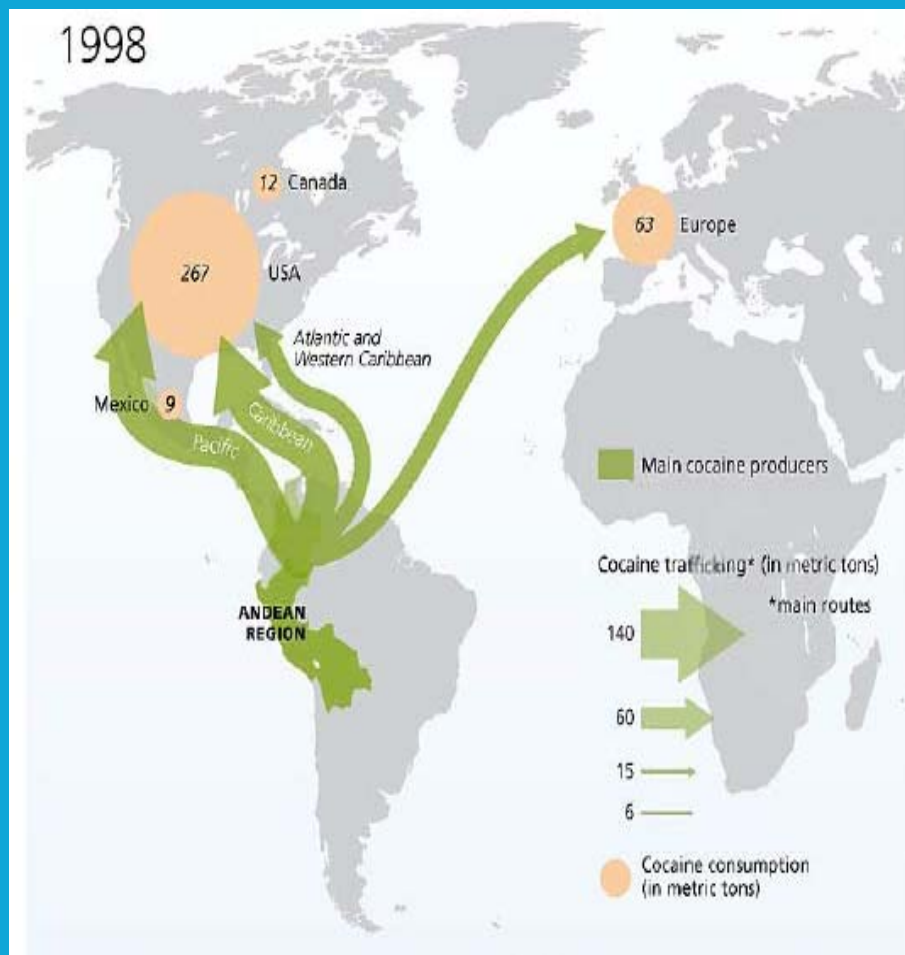
Estimated Value of Transnational Trafficking Flows, 2008



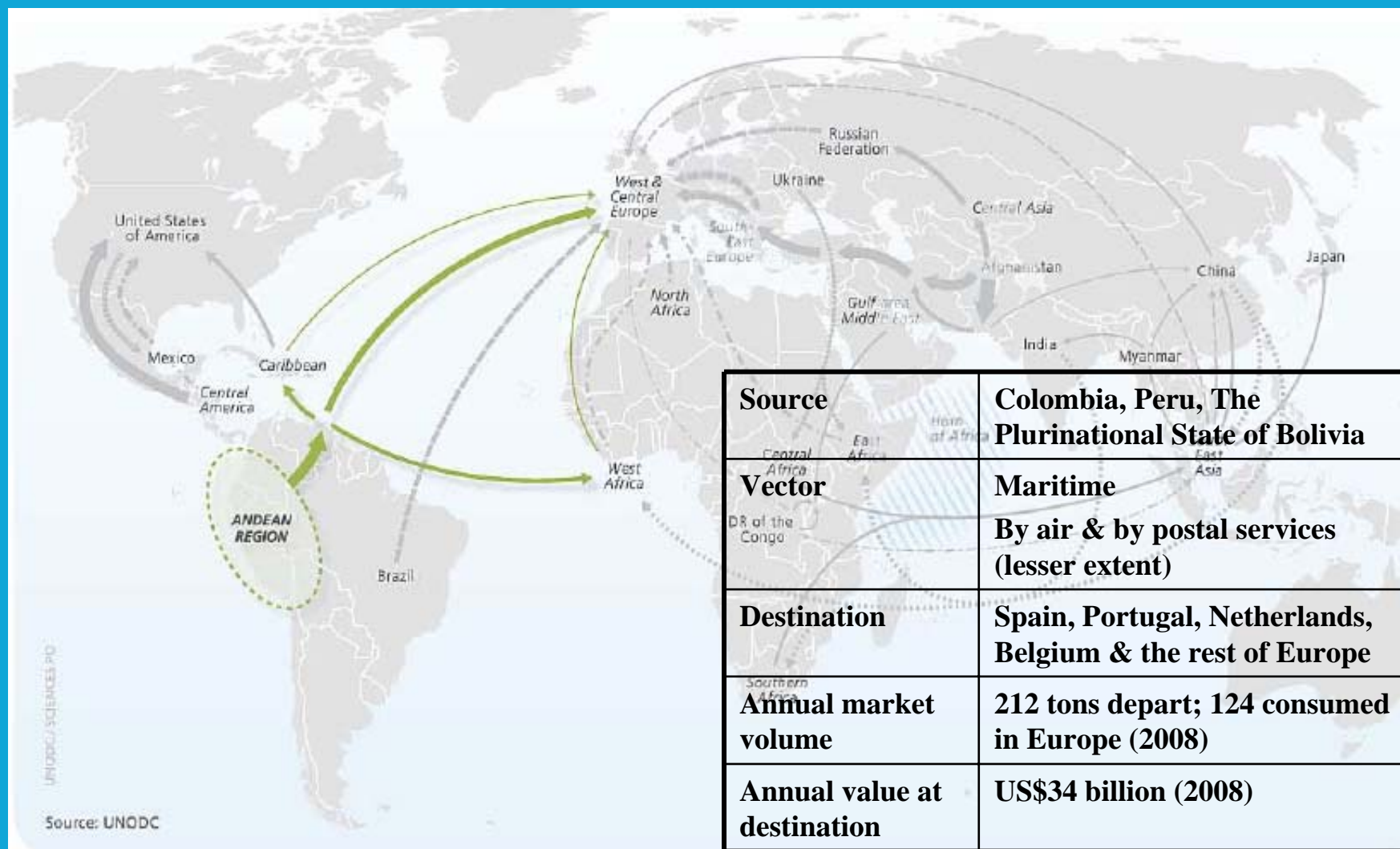

From the Andean Region to Europe





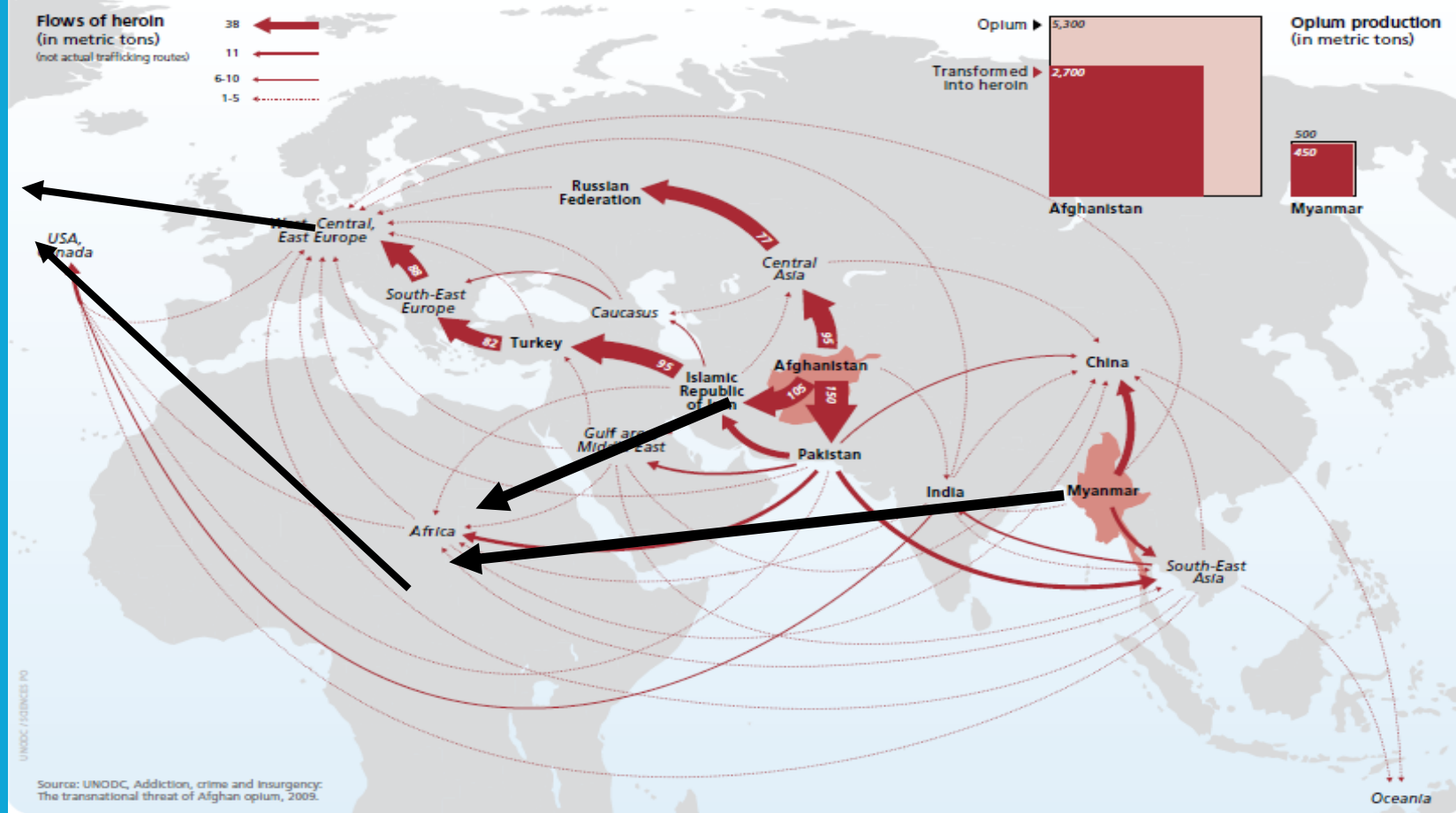

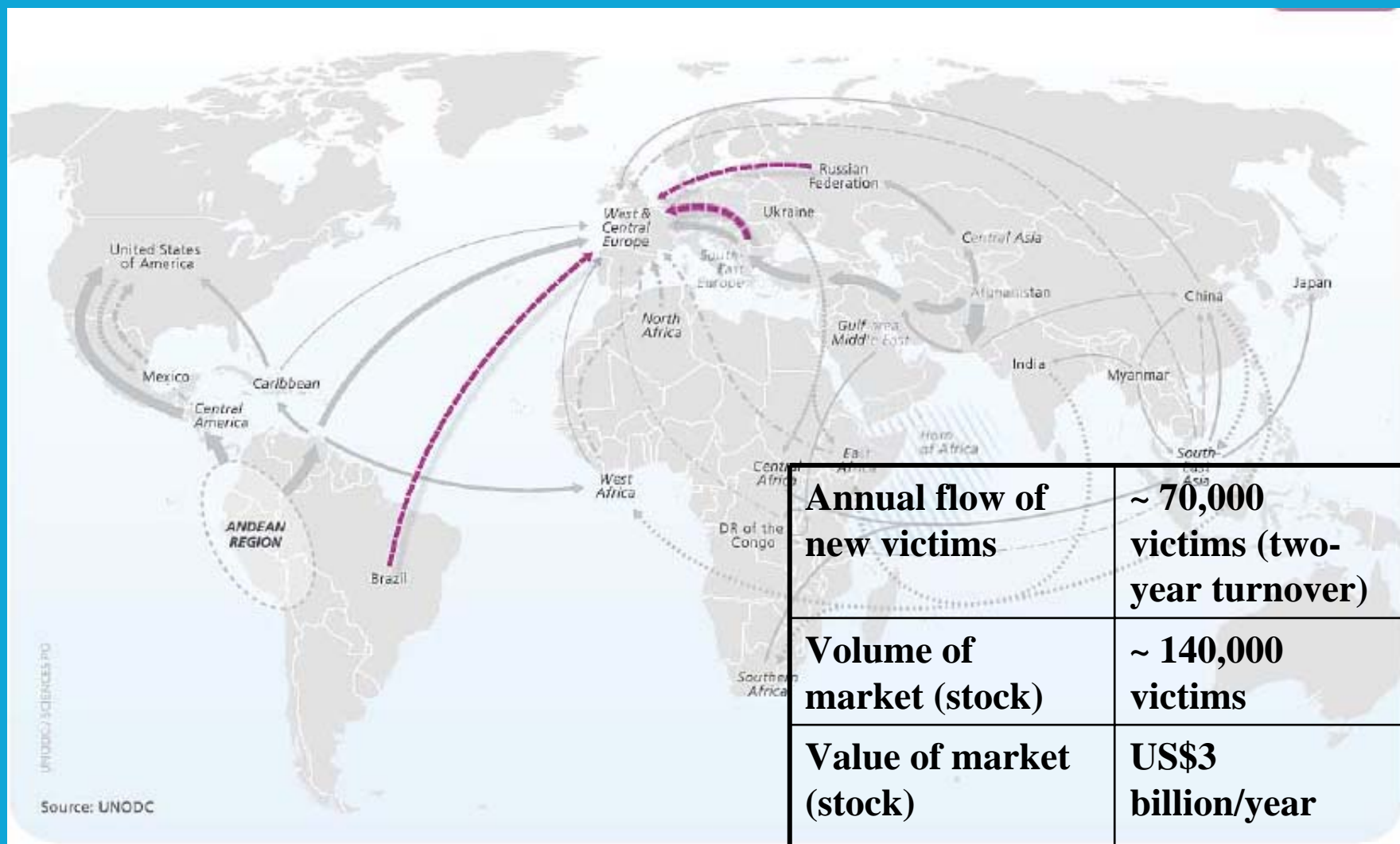

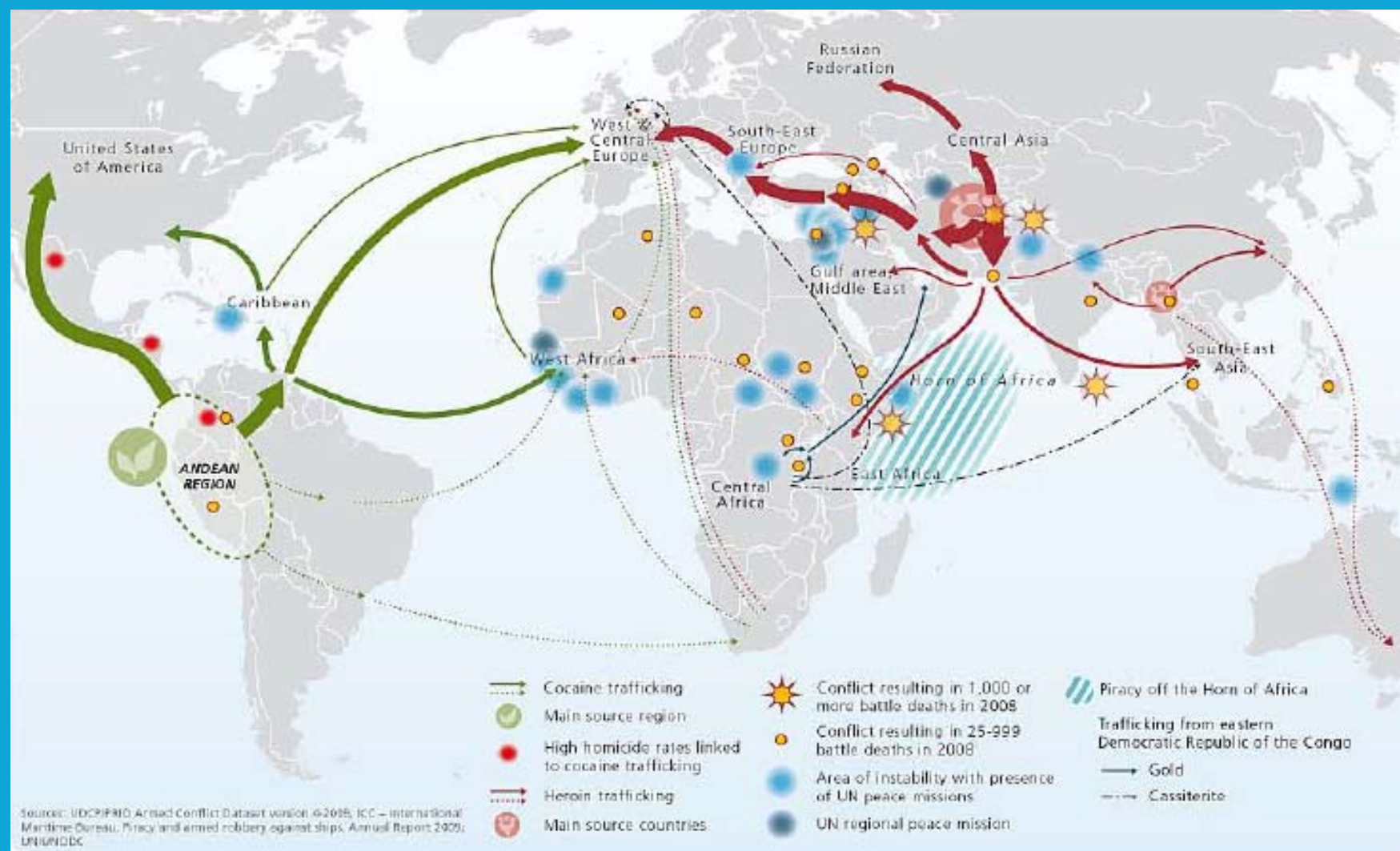
OPIUM PRODUCTION AND GLOBAL HEROIN FLOWS, AVERAGE 2002-2008

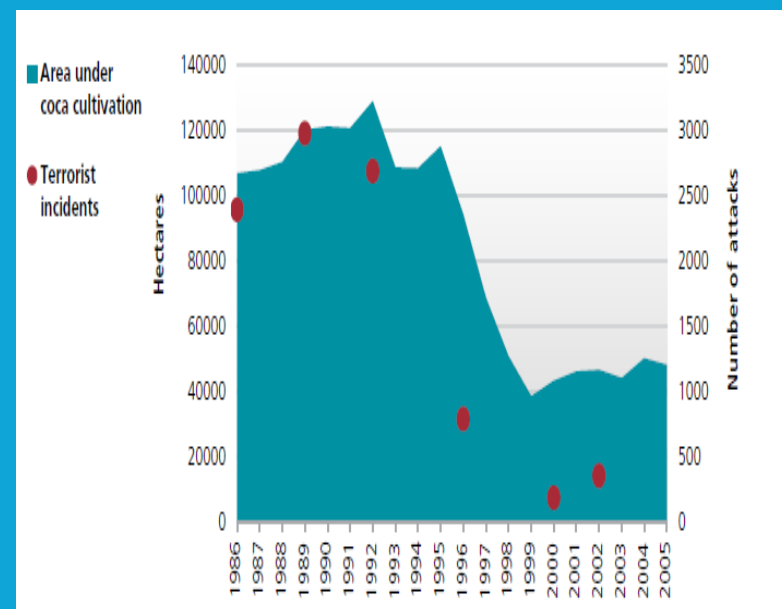
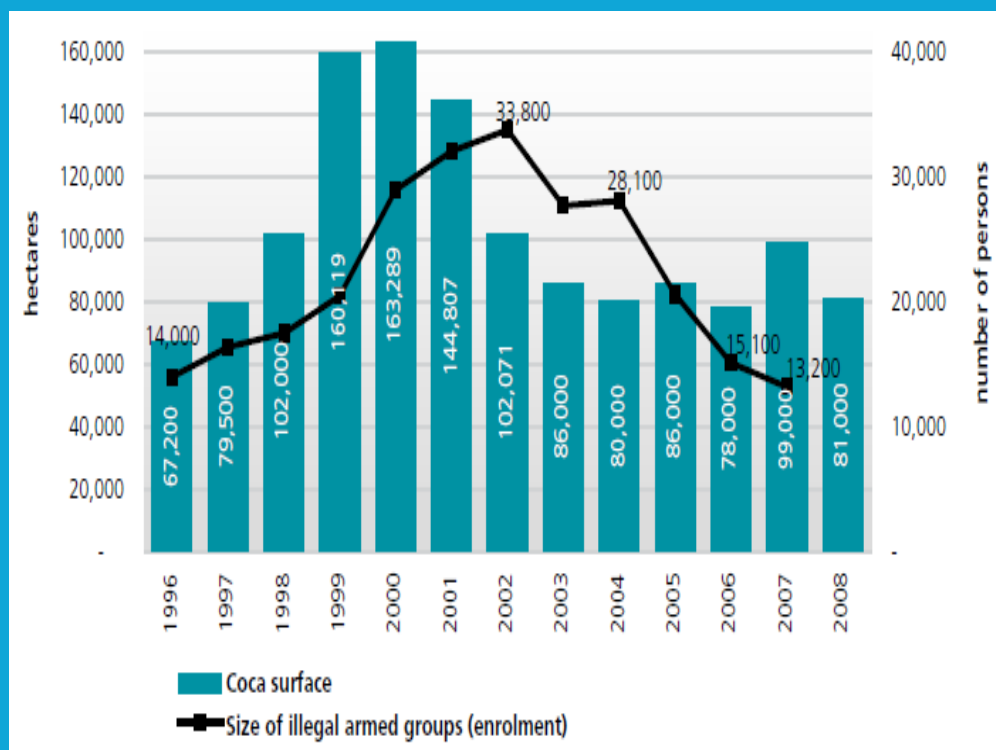

Coca cultivation & size of illegal armed groups, Colombia



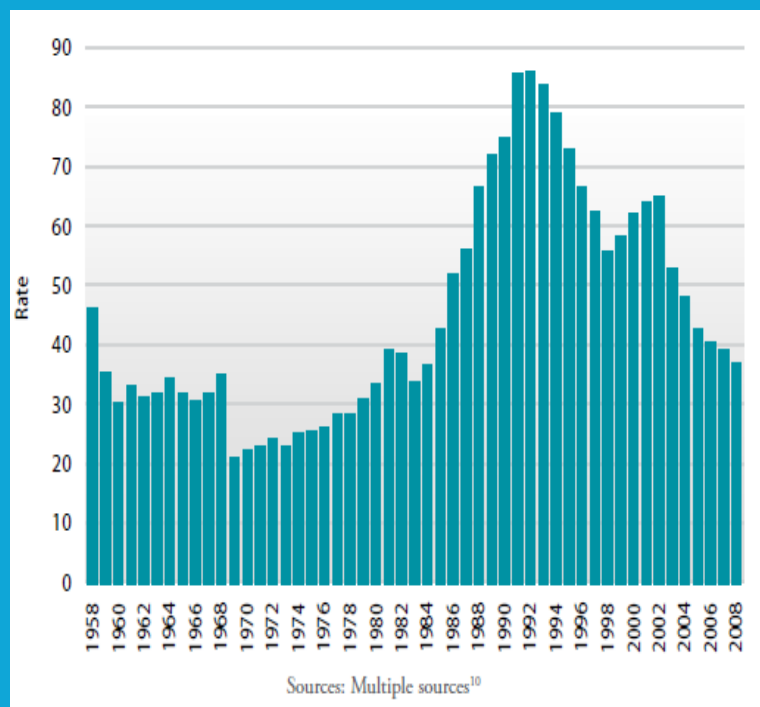
Area under coca cultivation

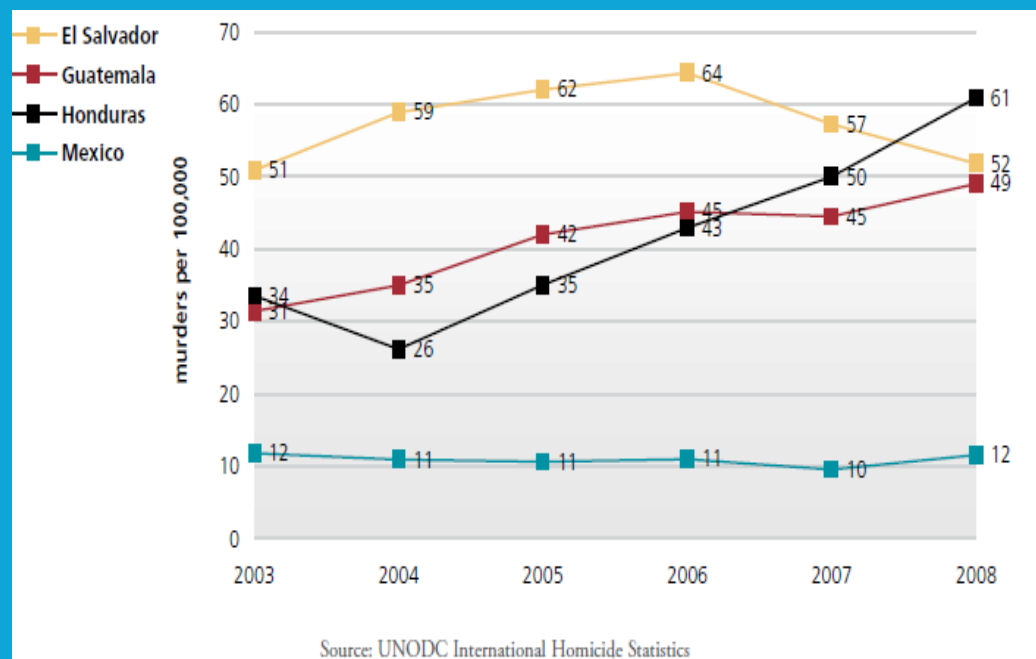

Murder rate trends in Mexico & Central America (per 100,000 inhabitants), 2003-2008



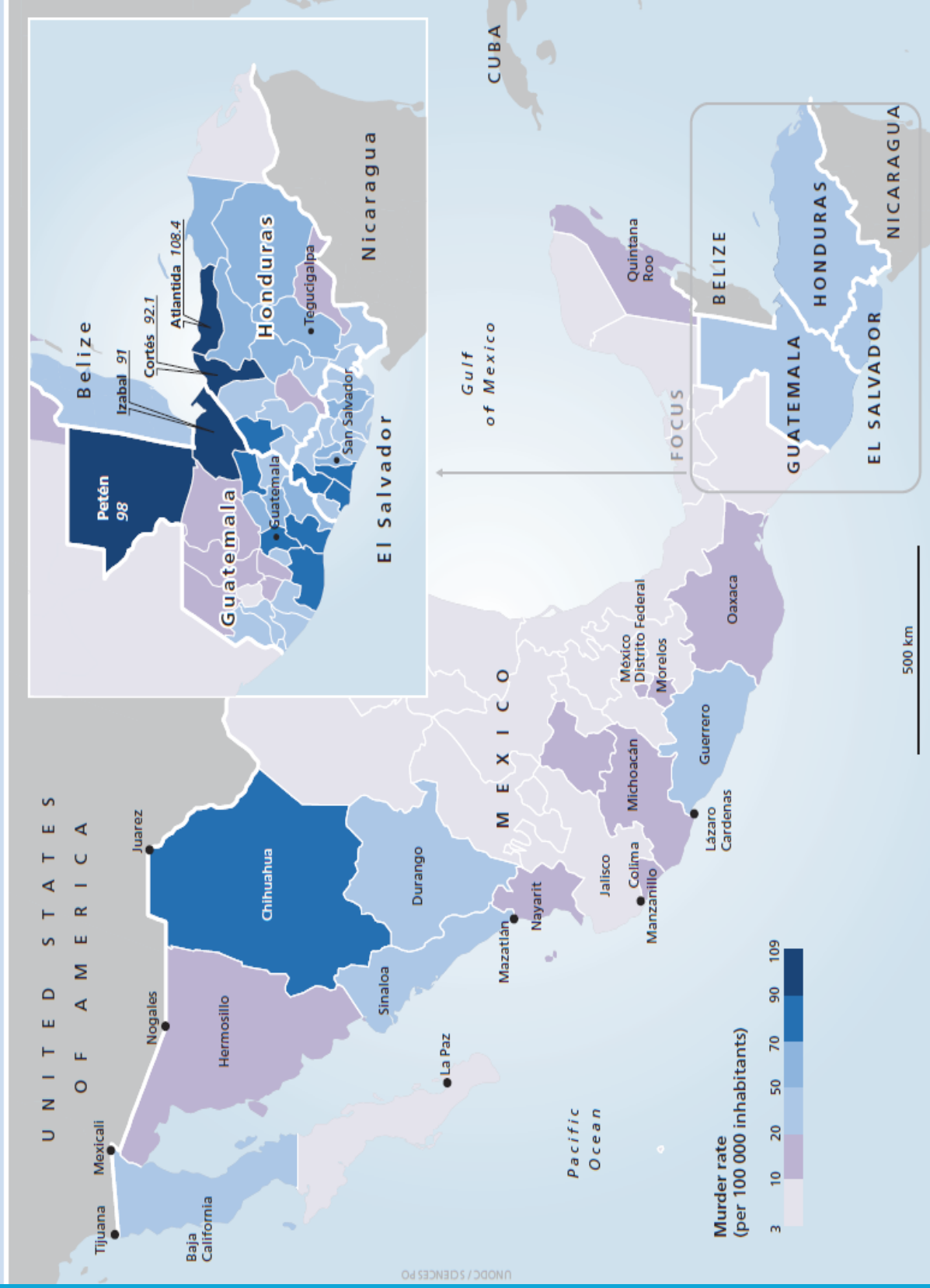
