




# **Main Global Transnational Organized Crime**





#### **Estimated Value of Transnational Trafficking Flows, 2008**








# **Cocaine Trafficking Routes**










## **Heroin Trafficking**












#### **Impact of Cocaine Trafficking**

Coca cultivation & size of illegal armed groups, Colombia






Area under coca cultivation & terrorist incidents in Peru, 1986 - 2005






Homicide rate in Colombia (per 100,000 inhabitants), 1958 – 2008
